

## **Warranty**

Our “Standard” and “Premium” Black featheredge is backed by a 7 year manufacturer’s warranty. The warranty will cover the material replacement, free of charge, of any boards proven to have failed because of fungal decay or insect attack.

Terms of warranty commence upon date of original installation.

### **Conditions of Warranty**

Materials shall have been supplied by MBM Speciality Forest Products Ltd. or approved retailer. Proof of date and purchase, must be provided. Proof of purchase and application of a recognised preservative end sealer is also required. The warranty period will commence on the date of purchase.

The product will have been installed and maintained in accordance with the installation and maintenance guidelines prescribed.

It does not cover the performance/failure of the paint or colour change, staining or surface mould associated with the normal weathering of external timber. It does not cover the removal or reinstatement of material, or consequential costs or loss due to the failure of the boards.

The term “fungal decay” as used in the warranty refers to wood destroying fungi that feed on and degenerate the wood cells.

The term “failed” as used in this warranty refers to damage caused by fungi or insect attack to the extent that the board is no longer fit for purpose.

### **Exclusions**

Product used in conditions more severe than use class 3A. This will include “in ground contact” or sever exposure to wetting beyond normal exposure to the weather. For example, extreme wetting caused by a broken gutter or downpipe.

Degradation caused by poor maintenance or poor installation practices. EG. insufficient air circulation.

Product removed from its original installation and re-used elsewhere.

Product used outside of the UK

Featheredge boards used for any other purpose than vertical plain external cladding.

### **Transferability**

The warranty may transfer to new owners of a building without notification. The warranty, and conditions of the warranty will remain unchanged.

The warranties are manufacturer to consumer warranties. However, the initial claim against warranty should be directed to the authorised retailer from where the goods were purchased. The claim should be made in writing / email and must include proof of purchase.
